**SALUTE TO FLAG**

Supervisor Green welcomed everyone to the Town Board meeting and said that there were several things which were going to take place before the first public hearing. He introduced members of the New York Police Department Narcotics Bureau of Manhattan North who were attending the meeting to make a presentation to Police Chief Biasotti. Their Commanding Officer Ken Cully thanked the New Windsor Police Department for their handling of the tragic death of a member of their department, Griselda Espinal, on August 11, 2006, at her residence in Butterhill. He thanked Chief Biasotti for his department's professional handling of every aspect of the investigation. Inspector Cully said that the New Windsor Police Department exhibited professionalism, expertise and dedication and just as importantly exhibited compassion to the members of the New York City Police Department for the loss of a member of their unit. He presented a plaque on behalf of all the members of the Narcotics Program of Manhattan North and the family of Griselda Espinal thanking all the members of the New Windsor Police Department.

The next item was the appointment of a new police officer.

Motion by Councilwoman Mullarkey, seconded by Councilwoman Biasotti that the Town Board of the Town of New Windsor appoint Mr. Hardy K. Pierce III as a Town of New Windsor Police Officer, effective September 5, 2007.

Town Clerk Deborah Green administered the oath of office to Officer Pierce.

Supervisor Green also congratulated Lieutenant Michael Farbent who will be attending the FBI National Academy, only the fourth member of the New Windsor Police Department to have ever done so.

The Town Clerk presented proof of publication as required by law.
