

**PUBLIC HEARING

Supervisor Green called to order a Public Hearing regarding the Orange County Community Development FY-2010 Program, and presided over same.

The Town Clerk presented proof of publication regarding same, as required by law.

John Szarowski, a consulting engineer with the firm of McGoey, Hauser and Edsall said that the town is applying for the grant to make drainage improvements from Oak Street over to the railroad trestle. Next year's grant will be used to extend the drainage improvements even further. Supervisor Green said that they will be applying for further grants for more work on a pond on the opposite side of Union Avenue.

Supervisor Green said that the Community Development Block Grants are based on census blocks which have to meet certain criteria and the Town of New Windsor has very few eligible census blocks left in town which qualify for these grants. He asked if anyone in the audience had any ideas for projects that the town could use CDBG money for.

Cathy Braun asked if the engineer would go over the areas again where the extended drainage swale was going to be placed.

Hearing no one else wishing to speak, Supervisor Green entertained a motion to close the Public Hearing.
