

PUBLIC HEARING

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: Supervisor Green, Councilwoman Mullarkey, Councilwoman Weyant, Councilwoman Biasotti, Councilman Lundstrom

OTHER OFFICIALS PRESENT: Town Attorney Blythe, Police Chief Biasotti

Supervisor Green called to order the Public Hearing regarding the proposed amendments to the Vehicle and Traffic Local Law and the Town Clerk presented proof of publication as required by law.

Supervisor Green asked if anyone present wished to speak about the proposed local law.

The owner of the property at 5 Browning Road said he received no prior notice about this local law. Supervisor Green said that a four page notice of violation had been served on him for a variety of zoning code violations on November 24, 2009 and the public hearing notice has been in the newspaper. Supervisor Green said that the employees of the taxi company are parking their cars on the street and taking up the whole road, sometimes double parking and it is not fair to the neighborhood. The owner said he has told his employees to park on only one side of the road. The supervisor said that was not acceptable and there is ample room on the property itself to provide employee parking.

The Supervisor said that today he received a four page petition signed by 66 neighbors complaining about the business. He said an illegal body shop is being run out of the building; there are over forty unregistered vehicles sitting there and tires are all over the place and the area is supposed to be screened and it is not.

Supervisor Green said the building inspectors would certainly work with him to get the place cleaned up, but it is a residential area and it must be cleaned up. The owner said that he had cleaned up considerably from the previous owner and he wished his neighbors had come to him with their concerns and he would have done something about the situation. The owner asked if he could put up a building to cover the cars up and Supervisor Green said that he would have to apply to the Planning Board for that.

Leo Braun said that the dump truck full of tires is now empty and some of the cars are gone from the lot.

Hearing no one else wishing to speak, Supervisor Green entertained a motion to close the Public Hearing.
